**Preparatory activities:** the activities involved 15 participants.

**Location / Dates:** Milan, 30 June 2021

**Short description:** This activity consisted of an online workshop organised with the representatives of the partner organisations involved in the EU-MED project. During the workshop, the leading organisation (Fondazione G. Feltrinelli) distributed a *vademecum* containing the *how to* of the public events to the partner organisations, detailing the EACEA requirements on visibility, discussing the contents of the projects' website, and possible changes on the schedule of the events due to COVID.

### **Events:**

11 events have been carried out within this project:

#### **Event 1**

**Participation:** The event involved 75 citizens from the city of Palermo (**Italy**)

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in Palermo (Italy) from 18/08/2021 to 19/08/2021

**Short description:** The aim of the event was to raise awareness about the harsh reality of migration across the Mediterranean, included the rescue policies carried by national authorities, as well as the activities carried in the supranational sphere in this regard.

#### **Event 2**

**Participation:** The event involved 50 citizens, from the city of Limburg (**the Netherlands**)

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in Limburg (the Netherlands) on 24/09/2021

**Short description:** The aim of the event was to start a debate on the condition of migrant women in the hosting communities, highlighting the gender dimension of migration and the additional challenges faced by migrant women.

#### **Event 3**

**Participation:** The event involved 50 citizens, from the city of Brussels (**Belgium**)

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in Brussels (Belgium) on 07/10/2021

**Short description:** The aim of the event was to discuss what the artistic scene can do for the hospitality of migrants, and it was shared the experience/testimony of artists with a migrant background.

#### **Event 4**

**Participation:** The event involved 75 citizens, from the city of Azaroa (**Spain, Basque Countries**)

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in Azaroa (Spain, Basque Countries) on 14/11/2021

**Short description:** the aim of the event was to create, in a practical way, a connection between the migrants and the hosting community, by the means of a shared lunch in many different houses in the city of Azaroa.

#### **Event 5**

**Participation:** The event involved 50 citizens, from the city of Grenoble (**France**)

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in Grenoble (France) from 24/09/2021 to 24/10/2021

**Short description:** the aim of the event was to make the population aware of the conditions of the migrants in the Greek islands; during the event, a photographic exposition took place.

#### **Event 6**

**Participation:** The event involved 50 citizens, from the city of Paris (**France**)

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in Paris (France) on 22/01/2022

**Short description:** the aim of the event was to discuss the phenomenon of the climate migrants and what are the policy measure that are undertaken in France and by the EU, and what could be the way forward.

#### **Event 7**

**Participation:** The event involved 50 citizens, from the city of Lyon (**France**)

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in Lyon (France) on 22/01/2022

**Short description:** the aim of the event was to discuss the creation of an international cooperation project to help migrant artists to enter the local artistic scene.

#### **Event 8**

**Participation:** The event involved 75 citizens, from the city of Brindisi (**Italy**)

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in Brindisi (Italy) on 20/07/2022

**Short description:** the aim of the event was to discuss the living and working conditions of the migrant workers involved in the agricultural labour in Southern Italy.

### **Event 9**

**Participation:** The event involved 75 citizens, from the city of Hendaye (**France**)

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in Hendaye (France) on 20/07/2022

**Short description:** the aim of the event was to discuss how the migrant policy is reshaping the European frontiers and our perception of Europe as a geographic and imaginary space.

### **Event 10**

**Participation:** The event involved 50 citizens, from the city of Milan (**Italy**)

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in Milan (Italy) on 13/10/2022

**Short description:** the aim of the event was to discuss the condition of second-generation migrants in a urban setting, and how the education policy works for them.

### **Event 11**

**Participation:** The event involved 50 citizens, from the city of Brussels (**Belgium**)

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in Brussels (Belgium) on 26/10/2022

**Short description:** the aim of the event was to recollect the public events of EUMED and to share the insights that the project managed to put together during its entire life-cycle.
